Class 1 – The Basics

- The more frequently files change the more you need to back them up
- Left Click Single to Select, Left Click Double to Open, Right Click for Options Menu (Context Menu)
- Create Folders, Rename, Highlight All Files, Highlight Select Files
- Cut, Copy, Paste, Save, Save As

Class 2 – Hardware and Basic Burning

- Types of Drives – CD-Rom, DVD-Rom, CD-RW, CD-RW/DVD, DVD-RW
- Backup registry, favorites, documents, etc...

- Website: www.nero.com
- Now up to version 7, around \$79.95 for full version, may have come free with your computer or also included with some CD burners.
- Make Data Disc – Burn standard data files to CD's, this is best for backups.
- Make Audio CD – Make an audio CD that you can listen to in your car or audio player.
- Photo and Video CD – Make a photo or video CD that is playable in most DVD players. NOTE: This is not how you would want to backup your pictures.
- Copy Disc – Make a copy of a CD. NOTE: This does not work for DVD's because DVD's have security.

- www.roxio.com
- Easy CD Creator is now up to version 8; it typically costs around \$79.99 but may also come in a basic version available for free with your computer or CD/DVD Burner.
- Disc Copier – Allows you to make copies of CD's
- Disc Creator Classic is for making Data and Music CD's

In both programs you can drag-and-drop or browse to add files.
